Johnell Bell, CAG Co-Facilitator, welcomed CAG members to the meeting and introduced Lisa Keohokalole Schauer, CAG Co-Facilitator, who reminded members to center the space. IBR COST ESTIMATE

Frank Green, IBR Assistant Program Administrator, reminded the CAG members of the previous cost estimate in 2020 that was largely estimated from the previous efforts on CRC. He then explained the new cost estimate was developed around the IBR program area improvements. A Cost Estimate Validation Process (CEVP) was recently completed to provide independent review and validation of project cost and schedule estimates. Frank also provided more detail about what the CEVP process entails and what is included in the cost estimate. The new cost estimate is from \$5 billion to \$7.5 billion. Frank ended by answering questions from CAG members about the cost estimate.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Salomé Chimuku, Community Engagement Manager, provided an update on community engagement activities that recently took place. She also provided information on upcoming engagement plans leading up to the release of the Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement (SDEIS).

PUBLIC COMMENT

John Ley, a Clark county resident, wanted to see if someone could explain the decline in transit riders across the bridge that was released by Metro and RTC in a report released last month.
